In these unusual and unprecedented times, we recognize that students may face unexpected challenges in reaching their educational goals and require short-term financial support to achieve success. As part of the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF), in accordance with Section 1800(a) of the CARES Act, students with extraordinary financial hardship as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic may qualify for grant funding. The grant intends to provide emergency funding to help students meet urgent, basic needs such as food, housing, technology, healthcare, and childcare.

Funds are limited and will be disbursed equally among all eligible students that are in a payment period dated before June 30,2020 and after March 5, 2020.

All students must be in Satisfactory Academic Progress.

This funding is a grant and does not have to be repaid.

Applicants must meet the following guidelines: TIV Eligibility

Students must understand that:

1. NPTI has a limited amount of emergency grant money.
2. Student eligibility will be determined by the criteria above and the student must be in Satisfactory Academic Progress.
3. The funds received from the COVID-19 Student Emergency Grant fund may be considered taxable income by the Internal Revenue Service.
4. These funds are not counted as income for financial aid purposes.
5. NPTI will disburse the funding as quickly as possible, but it may take up to 10 to 14 business days.
